Description	Introduce three-bin kerbside collection system – Recycling, General Waste and Food Organics and Garden Organics (FOGO).
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Outcome

- The City is introducing the three-bin kerbside collection system to align with the Waste Authority’s Better Practice FOGO Kerbside Collection Guidelines
- The FOGO bin will collect organic food and garden materials which are recovered and processed into FOGO products, such as compost or soil conditioner.

Milestone

- Rollout to be completed by Summer 2027.
